“This is Jehovah’s doing; it is marvellous in our eyes’ (Psalm 118:23). It goes against the grain of the eschatological backdrop. Why is it a wondrous thing? First, the number of the candidates. Second, it is the quality of their profession. It is the measure of conviction behind their confessions. Thirdly, it is the experimental insight that each of the candidates possesses. The second and third points are undoubtedly due to the anointing and substance of the preaching. It is also probably attributable to the anguish and persecutions that the Christian brethren from China had to endure; not just to escape from hostile political climate but also considering the immense difficulty of finding truth against a battery of heresies and a swath of confusion encountered in the marauding apostasy that prevails today. Finding truth today is like searching for a needle in the haystack.”
