

**PREFACE**

*“Pastor showed the importance of being consistent in the application of the law because sometimes as a parent you can beat the child out of frustration and not because you see the evil spirits but because the child embarrassed you or gave you so much problems. Thank God for pastor who counselled us not to beat the child unless you are composed and know the intention of the caning. Thank God pastor took upon himself that attribute of an angry man. Previously, in every child’s thanksgiving, they thanked God for pastor applying the law on them. Thank God today pastor showed us Yeshua Christ Himself – the world looks at Him as the uncomely One while the world looks at Solomon as the wise one. But Yeshua Christ has come to establish the law and the prophets and in His uncomeliness He brings us this hope of salvation through His redemptive work. Speaking of the uncomely Christ was a very apt closure to pastor’s sermon—to remove pride and haughtiness within us. In this conference pastor has exalted the Lord Yeshua Christ in our hearts. I felt ministered when pastor said that Christ Yeshua has come down, sacrificed everything, He Who has created heaven and earth made Himself poor, so that we could be rich in grace; yet all of us have rejected Him. Pastor always directs us to Christ, he does not bring us to himself but to Christ; and also to lift up our heads to God the Father, the omnipotent God despite the great battles we are engaged in today. It is God in heaven Who, through especially divine providence, has really enabled us to triumph over our enemies. Thank God we are up here to behold the power and work of God in the midst of His people. It is music to the ears to hear of how God has accomplished and progressed His work in every part of the world. Thank God that it is the goodness of God that the parents from Ulster, Adelaide and Canberra are here to hear this message. Those who are not able to hear, these brethren may bring these vital messages to them. Thank God the passing of time has vindicated pastor’s faith in the Word of God. Thank God I can be up here to enjoy all these things. I feel strengthened as we go down the hill and there is also this renewed sense of purpose.”*

Some of the messages earlier, whether Nehemiah or Esther, they were ministered with a lot of freshness in them and today it was Proverbs, quite linked to the report but the fundamental things in this conference is what I spoke on preparatory work and what I spoke on Saturday – freshest of all – how we can prove to those under the realm of the False Prophet that when they think they are going to heaven, they may well be presumptuous and deluded rather than being honest or upright. I felt that is the message that you should consider about most of all. Even the chairman this morning prayed about the accomplishments of God – thank God for the works He had done using us but I felt the reports are only secondary. While they show the manner of my person and ministry, what is important is the Word of God and the doctrines of Christ so you got to go back to think not so much what God had done in China and India but what is in the Word of God. What I am trying to give to you whether this Sabbath message or yesterday’s message, especially when I spoke about Nehemiah - the Covenant that the elders of Israel made in the post captivity period and what Stephen and Paul spoke in Acts 7 and 28 respectively. The en masse Jewish’s rejection is a very significant fact. It tells us about our own possible disposition. He came unto His own and His own received Him not but also the world recognised Him not. The fact that we are living in the last days – the day of the great delusion—when men shall believe a lie because of their rejection of the love of the truth unto the damnation of their soul. You have to go and think; otherwise the attack will come against us. Is it true? Why are most Christians rejoicing in their faith and we are men of sorrow? Why are men in exhilaration, while we are men grieving as though we are in lamentation or bereavement? Go back and ponder upon what the Scriptures says! I have given you the evidences from OT and NT, the abundance of testimony from the Scriptures. For instance, if you look at Psalm 105 and Psalm 106, the Jews spurned the mercies of God and so were rejected; but so are professing Christians especially in our days. We are the Gospel Jews. This is the time of apostasy. See also in Jeremiah that the OT Jews rejected his message continually again and again. Even though they treated him well, they rejected Jeremiah’s overall message. How do we know that we are not the same? We are the by-products of the 20th and 21st centuries, afflicted with the Laodicean syndrome because we live in the last church age.
