I do not just want to say many words but have no actions. I fear that the end of my life will be a tragedy of a wasted life and end up in eternal damnation! Thank God for the love of pastor who wants us to be very serious with God. I was not just hearing the wonderful perspective from heaven, it was also a call to build up the house of God. What a wonderful summation from pastor!
