

PREFACE

“Greetings dear pastor, I feel very sad to learn that you are greatly afflicted physically and am praying for thee that Jehovah Rophe will heal thee speedily of all thy physical afflictions, that He be merciful to thee and to His Church to restore thy strength fully so that you can continue to fulfil the mandate He has given thee to restore all things before He smites the earth with a curse (Malachi 4). After you have preached to us the epistles of Paul at 2017 AD Bible pre-Conference and main Conference, I have been seeking to study Paul’s epistles to understand the things Paul wrote. I meditated not only on the Word of God but also on all the messages you have preached all these years, and also the comments and interjections you gave during each meeting you had with us be it in a formal or informal setting. All these 11 years, after God had so mercifully delivered me out of the false church to place me under thy special anointed ministry, I have been pondering on the many things you have preached and spoken to us which I have found to be things too hard for me to understand.

Pastor, you have told us that you are a follower of Paul who is a follower of our Lord Yeshua Christ (1 Corinthians 11:1). You have two ‘idols’; the one in the Old Testament is David and in the New Testament, is Paul. I thank God for raising thee up not only to restore the singing of the Psalms of David by metricating them but you have also restored the epistles of Paul by metricating portions of his epistles for us to sing too. I have also come to love to sing Paul’s epistles. My favourite is Philippians 2:5-11 because through all thy preaching and the strong application of the law to me, God the Father has so mercifully and compassionately revealed the great condescension of our Lord Yeshua Christ in His passion, to my heart and my soul in a very deep and special way, by His blessed Holy Spirit, so this portion of Paul’s epistle has also become very special and dear to my heart.

I marvel and am still in amazement when I continue to consider all these things, and all that the Lord Yeshua Christ, my Great Shepherd has led me and seen me through with His rod and His staff (Psalm 23:4) in this wilderness of my life and my spiritual pilgrimage. Thy ministry is truly very unique because of thy special calling and special anointing. In such a time of this darkest of the final apostasy that we are living in today, we are all beset with the spirit of Antinomianism and Liberalism. There is no other person I have known or heard or read of, who not only preaches the law the way you do, but also applies the law so strongly the way you do to us who are under thy ministry. You appear to some if not all, who are even in our midst under thy ministry, as being draconian in the manner you apply the law so strongly on us. Yet I have also heard some brethren who had personally testified that you are actually a very meek person. I must confess that I have been too blind to see this meekness that is in thee. Please forgive me for allowing the spirits of the Antichrist and False Prophet to assail me during moments of very fierce titanic battles of Armageddon fought within the very arena of my own soul, that I had even been secretly suspicious that you were seeking to control all our lives, even our personal lives, not only with much authority but also by much fear.

I have lived with the fear of man subconsciously from as young as the age of five, witnessing how my parents had quarrelled and fought violently with each other. And I had also subconsciously learned from young how to survive emotionally by pleasing man so that they would not get angry with me and scold me. I became the most submissive, least disobedient and least rebellious child among the three children my parents raised. When I got married to my husband, to my shock, I discovered that he is more angry and fierce than both my parents were! I then lived my life being controlled by the fear of my husband. So I was shocked after I came under thy ministry due to the strong application of the law by thee and also by some of our leaders. I felt that even my spiritual life was being controlled by the same kind of fear. I have been struggling with this fear under thy ministry all these years and have also tried to make sense of everything that I have experienced in my life under thy ministry.

Dear pastor, I wish to confess that I had almost thrown in my towel and left the church and thy ministry at one very critical juncture of my life last year, just shortly after you had left for USA because I was feeling too overwhelmed by the terror of this fear of man that started to haunt me even when I was sleeping. I couldn’t bear it any longer, I couldn’t cope with it anymore; I felt I was going to have a mental and emotional breakdown and would very soon end up in a psychiatric ward if I did not get some relief from such overwhelming fear. But then the thought of leaving the church and leaving thy ministry was also too heart-breaking for me to bear and I kept telling myself there is nothing wrong with thee and all that you have preached but the problem is with me because I do not have any spiritual reception, spiritual understanding but only intellectual knowledge of the Word of God. I kept telling myself, ‘I can’t do this to pastor! Pastor has sacrificed so much and invested so much not only the Gospel but also his own soul unto me (1 Thessalonians 2:8) to push me into heaven. And I can’t do this to Rhoda Soh! I’m helping her with the BRC work and she is already so very busy with so many responsibilities to fulfil. And I also can’t do this to Elisha Yee, my local pastor in KL Church! I’m a leading sister there to help him take care of the brethren. And I also can’t do this to

my brethren in Bt. Sentosa! We are all very weak and very desolate spiritually but we must stay together to help one another to fight this fight of faith (1 Timothy 6:12).’ So I became more desperate for my spiritual state because I could not deliver myself from the fear of man and this consciousness of man that have so gripped my heart and paralysed even my religious duties and performances therein. I felt I was getting more and more tormented by this fear (1 John 4:18). I was also beginning to hate doing things, going places and trying to say the right things in the house of God, in order not to get scolded or being reported evil of, so I cried to the Lord Yeshua Christ, the Captain of the host of the LORD (Joshua 5:14) to deliver my soul and not tarry, lest I forsake my own mercies and be swallowed up by the evil trinity in such a fierce titanic battle fought within the arena of my own soul!
